"The Attractiveness of Christlikeness in the Workplace" 1 Peter 2:18-25 Message #10 July 12, 1992

<u>Intro</u>

Message (Remember, real inside out change progresses along the path of suffering.)

Economic injustice (suffering in the workplace) calls for <u>respectful submission</u>, <u>not resentful compliance</u> because...

- A. that choice displays grace one of God's most attractive attributes to unbelieving supervisors and co-workers (18-19).
- B. that choice puts a protective hedge around our growing treasure in heaven the glory that continually attracts our hearts toward home (20).
- C. that choice models both an innocent and self-sacrificial spirit core ingredients in the love of God that attracts unbelievers (21-25).
